

1.5 The Kilmarnock Leisure Centre Trust is a registered Charitable Organisation with the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator (Registration Number SCO 08314).

The Trust is entered in the Register of Scotland at Edinburgh on the sixteenth day of January, Nineteen Hundred and Eighty Six and was presented for registration in the Books of the Lords of Council and Session for preservation and is registered in the said Books as follows:-

Minute of Agreement

Between

Kilmarnock and Loudoun District Council (KLDC)

(East Ayrshire Council by natural succession to KLDC)

Of the first part

And

The Trustees of the Kilmarnock Leisure Centre Trust appointed in terms of the Deed of Trust by the council date 30th October 1985 (who and whose successors as Trustees under the said Deed of Trust are hereinafter referred to as "The Trustees" of the second part.

Whereas the Council have caused the formation of a Trust for the purpose of providing and managing a Leisure Centre in Kilmarnock and the Council wish to enter into an agreement with the Trustees in terms of Section 15 and 16 of the Local Government and Planning (Scotland) Act 1982 for the provision of facilities for recreation, sporting and social activities for the inhabitants of Kilmarnock and Loudoun District (East Ayrshire Council).

The period of Lease of the Leisure Centre shall be 30 years from the date of entry which shall be the date of the Landlords execution of these presents, when vacant possession of the subjects let shall be given to the Tennants save as provided of this Clause Two.

The purpose of the Trust shall be to provide a Leisure and Recreation Centre on a site owned by the District Council at Titchfield Street, Kilmarnock; by resident within and visitors to Kilmarnock and Loudoun District (East Ayrshire), to provide facilities for the development of sport including coaching and training; to ensure that young persons, the disabled and minority of underprivileged social groups have access to the facilities on reasonable terms and otherwise to promote leisure and recreational activities within the District.
