



POLICY ON CONTROL OF INFECTION

Due to the nature of our business it is imperative that we take all steps possible to ensure that infection is controlled and all customers can expect a clean, safe and well maintained environment.

We will ensure:

- All equipment is cleaned and recorded on a regular basis.
- Children are encouraged to wash their hands after using the toilet.
- Children are encouraged to wash their hands after play before having a snack.
- Staff are trained to identify and deal with infections.
- Parents are notified of any risk of infection.
- Staff wear rubber gloves when dealing with bodily fluids, i.e. blood, urine, etc.
- That Children who are suffering from infection e.g. Chicken Pox, German Measles, Scabies, Impetigo, etc. are not permitted to use the facilities.
- All soiled clothing is put in a plastic bag and given to parents.
- That parents/carers of children who are suffering from sickness/diarrhoea are informed that the child should not use the facility for 48 hours.
